Gordon. There were 16 people in the audience.

Oath of Office Judge Ester Casillo administered the Oath of Office to Brian J. Kennedy. Mr. Kennedy was appointed by the Board of Commissioners to fulfill the unexpired term left vacant by Michael A. Vereb.

Election of President Ms. Madden requested nominations for the office of President of the Board of Commissioners; on motion of Mr. Bartoszek, seconded by Mr. Stojanovich, Ms. Daddario was nominated. Mr. Bartoszek then offered a motion that the nominations be closed, which was seconded by Mr. Stojanovich. On motion of Mr. Stojanovich, seconded by Mr. Speaker and unanimously passed, Ms. Daddario was elected President of the Board of Commissioners.
