

Due to continued demand for tee times and outing reservations, the enclosed Outing Contract must be executed to reserve Jeffersonville Golf Club for your event. Please read the all the materials before returning the contract with your deposit (*\$100 for tee times / \$500 for shotguns*), there have been changes made from previous years.

Depending on the number of players and the time/day of the week, you may reserve the golf course on a tee time basis, modified shotgun or full shotgun format. The requirements for each are listed on the next page.

Tee Time Outings

The final head count due 5 days prior to the event becomes the guaranteed minimum for billing purposes. If your count drops from this total before the outing, you are still responsible for the guaranteed amount.

Shotgun Outings

A second deposit equal to 50% of the guaranteed shotgun minimum is due 7 days prior to your event. Failure to make payment by this date will result in cancellation of your event, plus loss of the deposit.

Reserving times for your group means denying access to those times for anyone else. It is our recommendation that you collect fees in advance of your outing to cover last minute cancellations and no shows. The Outing Invoice must be settled on the day of play, and any shotgun and / or scoring fees must be paid separately from this invoice. You will be given these totals when contacted prior to the event.

The return of this signed contract, along with your deposit check (made payable to Jeffersonville Golf Club) will confirm your event date and time. This deposit is fully refundable, if cancellation notice is given at least (14) days before the day of your event.

Less than (14) days notice of cancellation will result in forfeiture of entire deposit amount.

GOLF COURSE INFORMATION

Jeffersonville Golf Club features an 18 hole, par 70 Donald Ross designed golf course that was restored in 2001 by Ron Prichard. Small undulating greens, well placed fairway bunkers and a good mix of long and short holes are some of the outstanding features of this classic layout.

Pro Shop

Jeffersonville Golf Club has a fully stocked, independently owned PGA pro shop to meet all of your outing needs. Prizes can be selected from our inventory or you may special order items, such as logo balls, designed specifically for your event. Our vendor contacts will save you time and expense for your group event. Gift certificates are available for either rounds of golf, lessons or merchandise.

Locker Rooms

Mens and ladies locker rooms are available, with showers, for tournament participants.

Snack Bar/Restaurant

Located near the pro shop, the snack bar/restaurant serves hot and cold sandwiches, snack foods and an assortment of cold drinks. It has a full service bar, with beer, wine and liquor available. Upon request, groups may arrange for “at the turn” items that can be billed with the golf outing (see enclosed choices). *All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from the golf course, bringing your own is not permitted.*

Picnic Grove

Situated between the 1st green and overlooking the 18th fairway, the picnic grove is ideal for groups looking for an outdoor setting. Picnic tables, an enclosed kitchen area and restrooms are provided, all in a covered pavilion setting. Our Banquet Manager can help arrange a menu for your group, or you may choose to self cater the event.

Banquet Rooms

For groups that prefer an indoor setting, the Banquet rooms at Jeffersonville can accommodate groups from 24 to 200. The smaller meeting room seats 60 guests, the large ballroom offers flexible seating arrangements complete with a full service bar. A service kitchen is available, we can arrange for catering on the premises, or you may choose from our approved catering affiliates.

OUTING SERVICES

All shotgun starts receive the following: add \$1.00 to per person on separate invoice

- Complete cart set up and staging area
- Cart signs with player names and starting hole assignments
- Custom scorecards for scoring
- Placement of rules/info sheets and giveaway items on each cart
- All skill hole signage (closest to pin etc.) set up and retrieval
- Placement and retrieval of all hole sponsor signage

The group contact must provide a written list of pairings at least (5) day's prior to the event
All outing materials must be delivered (2) hours prior to the start to insure placement by staff

Professional scoring (optional)

- available for additional \$1.00 per person (individual stroke play)
- available for additional \$2.00 per person (team scoring)

TEE TIME OUTING CONTRACT

AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between Jeffersonville Golf Club and _____ (“Group/Individual”).

1. Group/Individual reserves JGC course for a Tee Time Outing on _____, 2007, for a period of time necessary to conduct such outing as determined by the Golf Club.
2. Group/Individual has paid a deposit to the golf club in the amount of \$100, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. This deposit will be applied to the balance of the total fee due as provided hereunder, provided however, that should the event be canceled by Group/Individual less than 14 days prior to scheduled event, said deposit will be forfeited.
3. At least (14) days prior to the event, Group/Individual shall provide an updated head count.
4. Group/Individual shall provide a final head count of those attending event (5) days prior to event.
5. The final head count will be the basis for calculating the total fee due for the event pursuant to the schedule of minimum players and rates attached as “Outing Services”, even if a smaller number actually attends. The amount due must be paid prior to the start of play on the date of the event, and if said sum is not paid at that time, the above-referenced deposit will not be applied to the amount due.
6. If professional scoring is requested, scoring fees will be on a separate invoice from golf course fees.
7. A copy of the Jeffersonville Golf Club Rules is attached. It is the responsibility of the outing representative of the Group/Individual to communicate these requirements to all outing participants.
8. All participants are required to abide by the posted rules and regulations of the Golf Club. Failure, by any participant, to abide by these rules will result in the removal of the individual(s) from the facility.
9. The Group/Individual reserving the golf course pursuant to this contract shall be responsible for any and all damage to property or persons caused by outing participants.
10. In the case of inclement weather on the day of the event, where the golf course is deemed unsafe or unplayable by the golf course staff, the outing shall not be held on that date, in which case the Group/Individual shall have the option of either rescheduling or being refunded the amount of the deposit.

SHOTGUN OUTING CONTRACT

AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between Jeffersonville Golf Club and _____ (“Group/Individual”).

1. Group/Individual reserves JGC course for a Shotgun Outing on _____, 2007, for a period of time necessary to conduct such outing as determined by the Golf Club.
2. Group/Individual has paid a deposit to the golf club in the amount of \$500, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. This deposit will be applied to the balance of the total fee due as provided hereunder, provided however, that should the event be canceled by Group/Individual less than 14 days prior to scheduled event, said deposit will be forfeited.
3. At least (14) days prior to the event, Group/Individual shall provide to the Golf Club a head count of those attending. If the number of players is less than the minimum required for a Shotgun Outing on the date and time scheduled as set forth by the attached “Outing Services”, the Golf Club will convert the outing to a Tee Time Outing provided, however, that Group/Individual may preserve a Shotgun Outing by agreeing in writing to pay the minimum applicable Shotgun Outing fees as calculated.
4. Group/Individual shall provide to the Golf Club a final head count (7) days prior to said event.
5. At the time the final head count is submitted pursuant to Paragraph 4, Group/Individual shall pay to the Golf Club a 2nd deposit equal to 50% of the minimum applicable Shotgun Fee for the event as calculated pursuant to “Outing Services”. Failure to pay this 2nd deposit by this date will result in cancellation of the event plus loss of the deposit described in paragraph 2.
6. The final head count will be the basis for calculating the total fee due for the event, even if a smaller number actually attends provided, however, that in no event shall the total fee be less than the minimum applicable Shotgun Outing fee as calculated pursuant to “Outing Services”. This amount due must be paid prior to the start of play on the date of the event, and if said sum is not paid at that time, the above-referenced deposit will not be applied to the amount due.
7. Shotgun/scoring fees will be added to above-described fees on a separate invoice from golf course fees.
8. A copy of the Jeffersonville Golf Club Rules is attached. It is the responsibility of the outing representative of the Group/Individual to communicate these requirements to all outing participants.
9. All participants are required to abide by the posted rules and regulations of the Golf Club. Failure, by any participant, to abide by these rules will result in the removal of the individual(s) from the facility.
10. The Group/Individual reserving the golf course pursuant to this contract shall be responsible for any and all damage to property or persons caused by outing participants.
11. In the case of inclement weather on the day of the event, where the golf course is deemed unsafe or unplayable by the golf course staff, the outing shall not be held on that date, in which case the Group/Individual shall have the option of either rescheduling or being refunded the amount of the deposit.

CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS

All players must register with the Golf Shop before starting and obtain a valid receipt

**Proper attire required: No metal spikes, collared shirts required, jeans discouraged
Tee shirts, tank tops, sweatpants and cut offs are not permitted**

No personal coolers or outside alcoholic beverages allowed

Golf cart operators must possess a valid driver's license, maximum two riders per cart

Golf cart fee is for a "shared" cart, no more than two carts per foursome

Golf cart riders must stay on cart paths near tees and greens, and adhere to stated cart restrictions

Each player must have his or her own set of golf clubs

Fivesomes are not permitted; singles and twosomes must pair up when asked by Golf Course Staff

If lightning is in the area, all play must stop when the alarm is activated

Rain Checks are issued only if course closed due to weather

Please respect the private property surrounding the golf course

Our goal for pace of play is four (4) hours and fifteen (15) minutes

Observe proper golf etiquette: repair ball marks, replace divots and rake footprints in bunkers

Stop Slow Play: keep pace, play "ready" golf, pick up after double par and move on to next hole

USGA Rules of Golf govern all play, except where modified by local rules
