Madden, Township Manager, with all Commissioners present, along with Judge Casillo, Richard Watt, Rhea Gallagher, Robert Adams, A. Dale Mabry, Thomas F. Cinaglia, Joseph Estock, Michael Valyo, and E. Van Rieker. There were 13 people in the audience.

- Executive Session** An announcement was made that Executive Session was held prior to the public meeting to discuss a personnel matter. No action was taken.
- Oath of Office** Joseph A. Byrnes presented his Certificate of Election for Commissioner of West Norriton Township and the Oath of Office was administered by Judge Casillo
- Brian J. Kennedy presented his Certificate of Election for Commissioner of West Norriton Township and Judge Casillo administered the Oath of Office.
- Election of President and Vice President** Ms. Madden requested nominations for the office of President of the Board of Commissioners; on motion of Mr. Bartoszek, seconded by Mr. Stojanovich, Ms. Daddario was nominated. Mr. Bartoszek then offered a motion that the nominations be closed, which was seconded by Mr. Stojanovich. On motion of Ms. Byrnes, seconded by Mr. Stojanovich and unanimously passed, Ms. Daddario was elected President of the Board of Commissioners.
- Ms. Daddario requested nominations for the office of Vice President; on motion of Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Byrnes, Mr. Bartoszek was nominated. Ms. Daddario then offered a motion that the nominations be closed, which was seconded by Mr. Kennedy. On motion of Mr. Stojanovich, seconded by Mr. Byrnes and unanimously passed, Mr. Bartoszek was elected Vice President of the Board of Commissioners.
- Public Comment** Ms. Daddario called for Public Comment; no one wished to speak, on motion of Mr. Bartoszek, seconded by Mr. Byrnes and unanimously passed, the public comment portion of the meeting was closed.
