Ms. Daddario, President of the Board, convened the monthly work session of West Norriton Township at 7:00 p.m. on the above date. **Zoning Change
Hearing**

Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 12, 2008, for the purpose of considering the enactment of an Ordinance regarding a zoning change for storage structures and garages.

**Proposed Zoning
Change Ordinance**

Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will consider an Ordinance, amending Chapter 27, Sections 301 and 1406 of the Code of Ordinances changing the permitted area of storage structures to 250 square feet, requiring that such structures be peaked and have a height of no more than 10 feet, requiring that garages be peaked and have a height of not more than 14 feet and changing the required setback from any property line for garages from 10 feet to 4 feet.

Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will consider a Resolution adopting an amended West Norriton Township Emergency Management Plan.

**Proclamation
AMBUCS Visibility
Month**

Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will present a proclamation at next weeks meeting to the West Norriton Chapter of AMBUCS, proclaiming the month of February as AMBUCS Visibility Month.

Comments

Mr. Cinaglia commented that PennDot will start construction shortly on a third lane westbound on Route 422 in the Betzwood Bridge area. All work will be done in the evening hours, to avoid problems during peak travel times. The project is slated to take eight months to complete.

Ms. Madden commented that the Solicitor's office is reviewing the contract drafted by Kittle Communications for the book compiled by the West Norriton History Committee.
