Ms. Daddario, President of the Board, convened the monthly work session of West Norriton Township at 7:00 p.m. on the above date. Present were Commissioners Bartoszek, Byrnes, Kennedy and Stojanovich; Robert J. Kerns, Karen E. Madden, Rhea Gallagher, Robert Adams and Thomas Cinaglia. There were three people in the audience.

**Announcement** Ms. Daddario announced there was an Executive Session held prior to Work Session to discuss a personnel matter. No action was taken.

**Zoning Change Hearing** Ms. Madden announced there will be a hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 11, 2008 regarding a zoning change for storage structures and garages.

**Proposed Zoning Change Ordinance** Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will consider an Ordinance, amending Chapter 27, Sections 301 and 1406 of the Code of Ordinances changing the permitted area of storage structures to 250 square feet, requiring that such structures be peaked and have a height of no more than 10 feet, requiring that garages be peaked and have a height of not more than 14 feet and changing the required setback from any property line for garages from 10 feet to 4 feet.

**Proposed Ordinance-WNT Sewer Authority** Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will consider an Ordinance amending Chapter 18 of the Code of Ordinances removing references to the West Norriton Township Sewer Authority, as it has been previously defensed and dissolved.

**Bid Opening-2008 Golf Carts** Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will consider the bids for the purchase of (10) 2008 Model 4-Wheel Golf Carts. The bid opening will take place on Friday, March 7, 2008.

**Bid Opening-Parking Lot Paving for the Marshall St. Rec. Site** Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will consider the bids for the 2008 Recreation Site Parking Lot Paving Project located on W. Marshall Street. This lot provides off street parking for the girls softball fields. The bid opening will take place on Friday March 7, 2008.

**Adjournment** There being no further business, at 7:10 p.m., on motion of Mr. Byrnes, seconded by Mr. Stojanovich and unanimously passed, the public meeting was adjourned.
