**Resolution-Lease Purchase Agreement-Truck** Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will consider a Resolution authorizing the acquisition of equipment through the PACC (PA Capitol City) Program.

**Resolution-Permit Warrantless Arrests** Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will consider a Resolution permitting local police to make warrantless, on-view arrests in West Norriton Township.

**RETTEW Proposal Sewer Cleaning and Televising** Ms. Madden announced the Board of Commissioners will consider a proposal from RETTEW Associates, Inc. for engineering services to solicit bids for performing closed circuit television (CCTV) inspection of selected sewers within the West Norriton Township wastewater collection system.

**Notice of Retirement-Gerald Kaufman** Ms. Madden stated the Board of Commissioners will consider acceptance of Gerald Kaufman's notice of retirement letter, effective June 1, 2008.

**Anne Rohricht - Explanation of NASD Budget** Ms. Madden commented that Anne Rohricht from the Norristown Area School District will make a presentation at next weeks meeting regarding explanation of the NASD Budget.

**Comments** Mr. Kennedy commented there will be a Centennial meeting April 21, 2008 at 7:00 to discuss preparations for the Township's upcoming Centennial celebration in 2009.

Mr. Bartoszek commented a draft of the 537 Plan has been received and a meeting with Gannett Fleming will be scheduled.
