

NOTICE CONCERNING PET OWNERS

WEST NORRITON TOWNSHIP IS PROTECTING WATER QUALITY THROUGH THE FEDERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PHASE II STORMWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT PROGRAM. WEST NORRITON TOWNSHIP HAS ESTABLISHED A PROGRAM TO PREVENT, IDENTIFY AND REMOVE ILLEGAL DISCHARGES INTO AND OUT OF THE STORMWATER SEWER SYSTEM. ILLEGAL DISCHARGES ARE DISCHARGES THAT ENTER INTO THE STORMWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM THAT ARE NOT ASSOCIATED WITH STORMWATER RUNOFF OR AN ALLOWABLE DISCHARGE.

DISPOSING OF YOUR PETS WASTE INTO THE TOWNSHIP'S STORMWATER SYSTEM (INLETS AND DITCHES) IS CONSIDERED AN ILLICIT DISCHARGE. THOSE WHO ILLEGALLY DISPOSE OF PET WASTE INTO THE STORMWATER SYSTEM CAN FACE FINES OF \$1,000 PER OCCURRENCE. PET WASTE MUST BE PICKED UP AND DISPOSED OF PROPERLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH TOWNSHIP ORDINANCES.
