ORDINANCE NO. 2018-718

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WEST NORRITON TOWNSHIP CODE,
CHAPTER 15, PART 4, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE
RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS.**

It is ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of West Norriton Township as follows:

I. AMENDMENTS.

A. Chapter 15: Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Section 15-410, Residential Permit Parking, shall be amended so that Paragraph 3.A reads as follows: At all times, due to the mix of residential and non-residential uses, there are a significant number of vehicles that utilize the on-street parking capacity of that area. For the purpose of this criteria, a legal parking space shall be defined as 20 linear ft.

B. Chapter 15: Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Section 15-410, Residential Permit Parking, shall be amended so that Paragraph 4 reads as follows: Designation of residential permit parking areas:

(a) Residential permit parking shall be required at all times for the following streets and locations:

Centre Avenue	Both	W. Main Street to W. Marshall Street
Forrest Avenue	West	W. Main Street to W. Marshall Street
W. Main Street	Both	N. Montgomery Avenue to Forrest Avenue
N. Montgomery Avenue	Both	W. Main Street to W. Marshall Street
S. Montgomery Avenue	Both	Entire length

II. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed, it being understood and intended that all ordinances and the First Class Township Code, such as are not otherwise specifically in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect, the same being reaffirmed hereby.

III. REVISIONS. The Board of Commissioners of West Norriton Township does hereby reserve the right, from time to time, to adopt modifications of, supplements to, or amendments of this Ordinance, including this provision.

IV. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provisions shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after date of adoption.

VI. FAILURE TO ENFORCE NOT A WAIVER. The failure of West Norriton Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.
