WHEREAS, under Pennsylvania Act 1978-323, Title 35, an Emergency Management Coordinator was appointed by the Governor in 2002 for West Norriton Township; and

WHEREAS, under Pennsylvania Act 1978-323, Title 35, it is the Township's responsibility to prepare an Emergency Management Plan which can be implemented in the event of a large-scale emergency operation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of West Norriton Township hereby adopts the West Norriton Township Emergency Management Plan to ensure West Norriton Township's readiness in the event of such disasters.
