GENERAL INFORMATION

DROP OFF / PICKUP PROCEDURE

Parents are permitted on campus for drop off and pickup purposes only and must remain in their vehicle during drop off and pickup. During drop off your child will be escorted by a counselor. Counselors will sign in each camper and escort each child inside to their assigned seat. Once you arrive for pickup, a counselor will escort your child to your vehicle. ALL parents will receive an email with more information on our drop off and pickup procedures closer to the start of camp. These instructions will assist you on where our drop off and pickup lines will start. ALL campers must be picked up by 3:00 p.m. Late pickups will not be tolerated. Expulsion from camp will occur if this becomes an issue. **There will be NO supervision for your child/children before 8:45 a.m. and after 3:00 p.m.**

ABSENCES/ EARLY PICKUP

If you have a scheduled vacation or foreseen absence, please contact the Recreation Department at 610-630-1251 or email sdinolfi@wntwp.com to notify us of your vacation or absence. ANY child that will be picked up early **MUST** contact Stephanie DiNolfi at 610-630-1251. No child will be permitted to leave the grounds at any time without such notice. If for some reason you cannot get in contact with the Recreation Department, please call the West Norriton Township Building at 610-631-0450.

CAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

Toys, games, cards, any electronic devices, etc. may be brought to camp, but **West Norriton Township assumes no responsibility for any of these items if lost or stolen.** All items should be properly labeled with camper's name clearly visible. If your child must bring a cell phone to camp, it should be kept safely in a secure backpack. **Camp related posts to social media are prohibited.** Additional prohibited items include, but are not limited to weapons of any kind, toy guns, walkie-talkie radios and make-up. If a child brings any prohibited items to camp, the item will be confiscated and returned to a parent at the end of the day.

All campers should be dressed in comfortable, appropriate attire. Campers must wear closed-toe shoes to camp. If you are participating in the afternoon activity, you must have sneakers. Please apply sunscreen to your child daily. You may send sunscreen to camp with your child. Staff members, however, are not permitted to apply the sunscreen to your child. A reminder will be announced to re-apply at lunch.

Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunch and water bottle every day. It is recommended that lunch be packed in an insulated lunch bag. Campers will not have access to a refrigerator or microwave. Bags should be marked clearly with camper's name.

BEHAVIOR/DISCIPLINE POLICY

Appropriate behavior is expected of all campers. A respectful interaction with other campers and staff is expected and essential to an overall positive camp experience. Bullying, fighting, vandalism, and inappropriate language are strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated. **We reserve the right to send any child home that becomes a constant behavioral problem, whether for the day or for the remainder of the camp schedule. We do not refund money under any of the above circumstances.** Please reference the camper code of conduct for further information regarding behavior/disciplinary action. **Camper code of conduct MUST be signed and returned at the time of registration.**

MEDICAL INFORMATION

If your child has an allergy or asthma, please contact Stephanie DiNolfi, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation, before the start of camp at 610-630-1251 or at sdinolfi@wntwp.com. If your child needs their medication at camp, parents will need to provide their medications beforehand.

RAIN POLICY

Camp will be held rain or shine. Should it be raining before 8:45 a.m. or start to rain later in the day, we will remain in the school's cafeteria and/or gymnasium.

REFUND POLICY

A strict no refund policy will be enforced. Trips, performances, and special guest appearances are paid in advance and cannot be refunded!

TRIPS

ATTIRE - Each child who will be attending at least one trip, will be given a West Norriton Summer Camp t-shirt on the first day of camp. Campers **MUST** wear the provided shirt when attending trips or will not be permitted to go on the trip that day.

TRANSPORTATION - Transportation will be provided by First Student Bus Company.

PROCEDURE - Buses will depart camp promptly at the times stated in the packet. Campers are encouraged to pack a lunch for trip days unless otherwise stated that lunch is included in the trip fee. Campers will eat lunch before departing for most trips. Campers will be permitted to bring extra money to purchase something from the snack bar. Purchases will be made at their own discretion. Camp staff will not be responsible for your child's money.

PERMISSION SLIPS FOR DAY CAMP TRIPS - All permission slips are due at time of registration. A permission slip for each child must be submitted as part of the registration process.

SKYZONE WAIVER - Any camper that is signed up for and attending the Skyzone trip will need to have a waiver signed electronically by a parent or legal guardian. The waiver is located on the Skyzone web page at <https://www.skyzone.com/oaks>. Please submit the waiver by **May 1, 2026**, so your child can participate in the field trip. **Neglecting to sign the waiver will result in your child to stay back at camp.**

MAGIC BY STUART - Stuart the Comedy Magician will perform a 45-minute "Comedy Magic Show."


LILLO'S WATER ICE - JUNE 25TH & AUGUST 5TH

West Norriton Township Parks & Recreation Summer Day Camp Disciplinary Policy

West Norriton Summer Day Camp is meant to be a fun and safe program. For the benefit of all campers, it is important that children behave appropriately during camp. If it becomes necessary to take disciplinary action, the steps will be followed as outlined below:

1. The camper will receive a verbal warning and an explanation as to why the behavior is inappropriate (whenever possible, this will be done in a secluded setting, away from other campers).
2. If behavior or action persists, the camper will not participate in daily activity. Parents will be notified of the issue when they pick up their child, or they will be called.
3. If a camper's behavior continues and does not improve, parents will be notified that they must pick up their child from camp immediately.
4. If upon returning to camp, the camper's behavior or actions persist, the camper will be dismissed for the remainder of the program without refund.

I have read the above CAMPER'S CODE OF CONDUCT. I agree to adhere to all the above to ensure that my camp experience and the experience of other campers is a positive one. I understand that failure to adhere to these rules may result in my dismissal from the program.
